WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small pieces of data, stored in text files, that are stored on your computer or other device when websites are loaded in a browser. They are widely used to remember you and your preferences, either for a single visit ("session cookie") or for multiple repeat visits ("persistent cookie"). They ensure a consistent and efficient experience for visitors, and perform essential functions such as allowing users to register and remain logged in. Cookies may be set by the site that you are visiting ("first party cookies"), or by third parties, such as those who serve content or provide advertising or analytics services on a site ("third party cookies").

THE TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

Essential cookies

These are necessary cookies, without which the Website won't work properly or be able to provide certain features and functionalities. Some of these may be manually disabled in your browser but may affect the functionality of the Website.

Preference cookies

Preference cookies are used to recognize repeat visitors to the Website. We use these cookies to record your browsing history, the pages you have visited, and your settings and preferences each time you visit the Website.

Statistics cookies

Analytical cookies monitor how users reached the Website, and how they interact with and move around once on the Website. These cookies let us know what features on the Website are working best and what features on the Website can be improved.

Third-party cookies including Marketing cookies

While using integrations with external service providers on our Website, those providers may set cookies to track the visitor for their purposes. These cookies can be used to track you on other websites that use the same third-party service. Such third-party cookies are not under our control and additional information is provided under their own third-parties' cookie notices.

Marketing cookies are placed on your computer by advertisers and ad servers in order to display advertisements that are most likely to be of interest to you. These cookies allow advertisers and ad servers to gather information about your visits to the Site and other websites, alternate the ads sent to a specific computer, and track how often an ad has been viewed and by whom.
